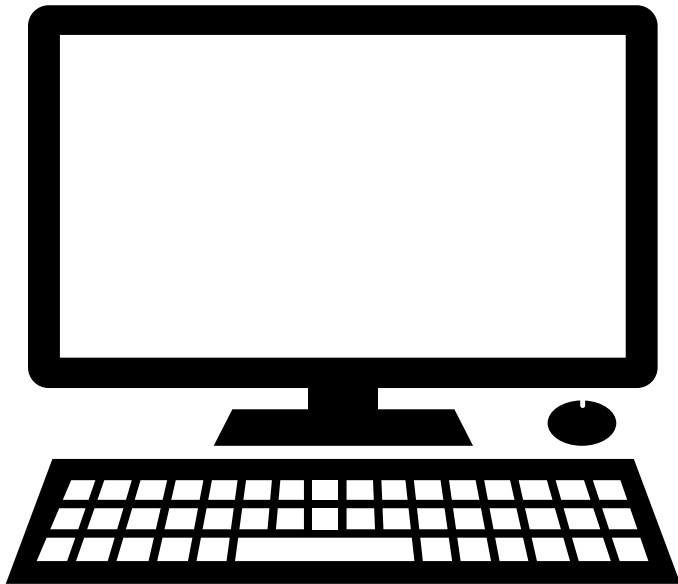

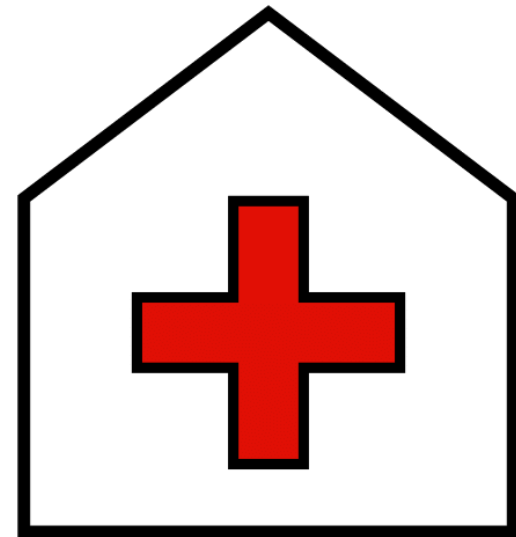

You can:

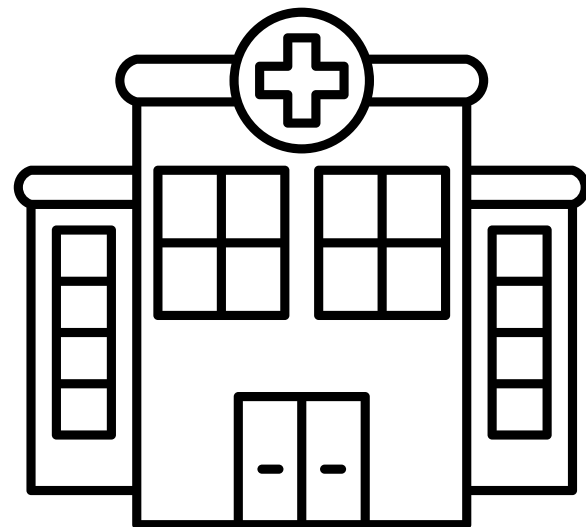
- Read it on your own

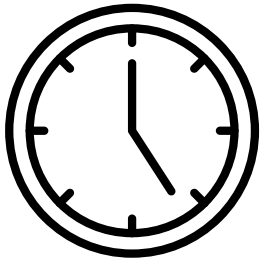

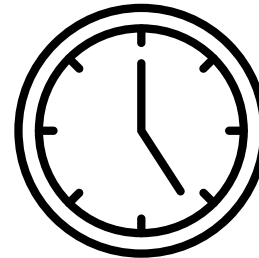

Choosing Your Doctor

You have a named GP.

We try to book you with your usual GP.

You can ask for a different GP.



Appointments

You need an appointment to be seen.

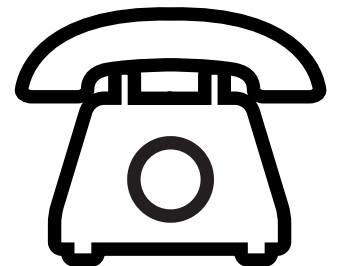
You can book:

- By phone
- Online
- At reception

Same day appointments are for urgent problems.

You can ask for a telephone appointment.

The doctor will call you.



Home Visits

Home visits are only if:

- You cannot leave your home
- You are very unwell
- You are near the end of life

Ask before 10.30am

A GP decides if a visit is needed.



Joining the Surgery

You can join if you live nearby.

You can:

- Register online
- Ask reception for a paper form

You may have a health check with a nurse.

We treat everyone fairly.

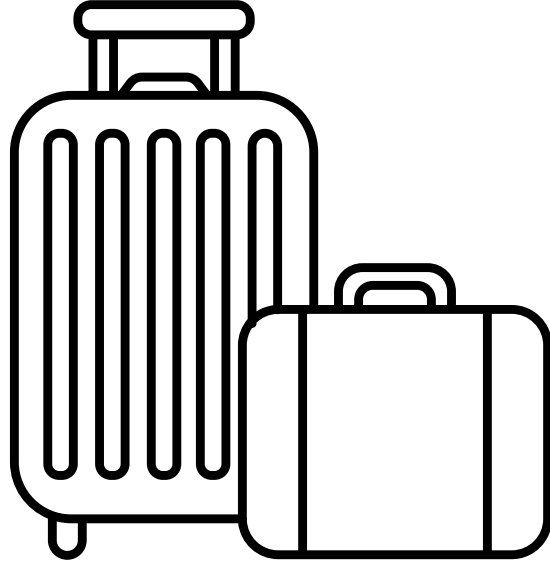


Temporary Patients

If you are staying less than 3 months:

- We can register you temporarily
- This is for urgent care only

Ask reception.



Are you a Carer?

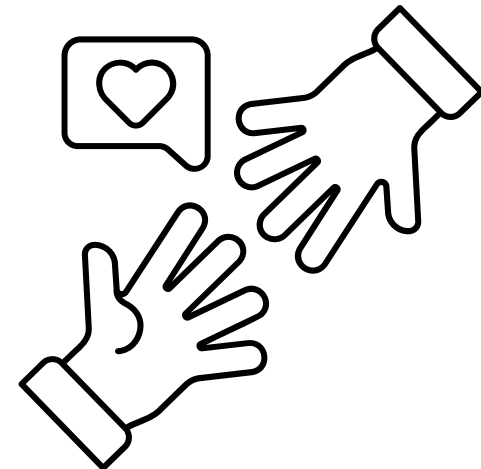
A carer helps someone who needs support.

- Wellbeing team

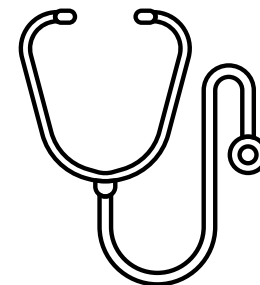


Services We Offer

Medicines

If you take regular medicine:

- Order early
- Allow 48 hours before you collect

Do not run out.

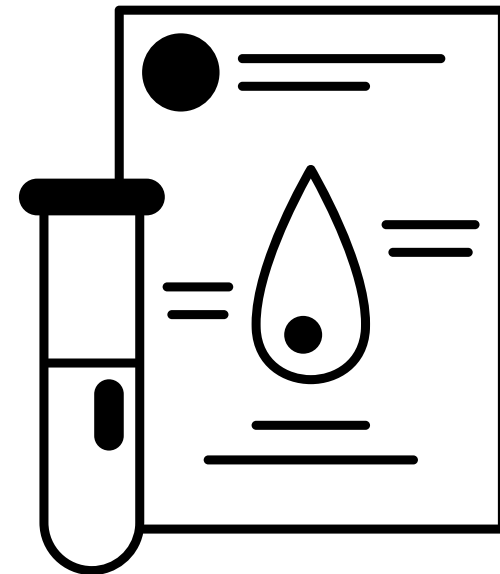


Test Results

Results are only given to you or your registered carer with your consent.

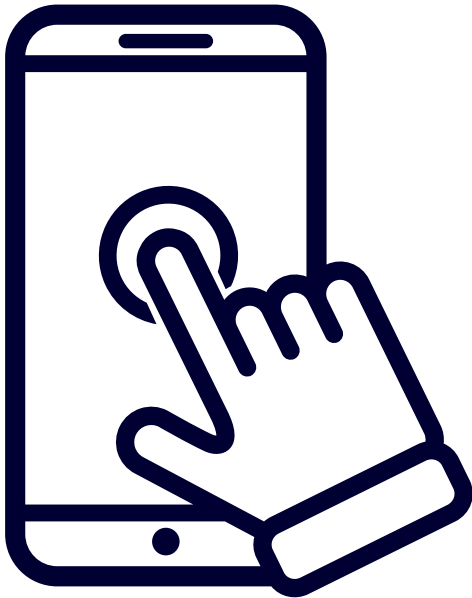


Online Services

Ask for help if needed.



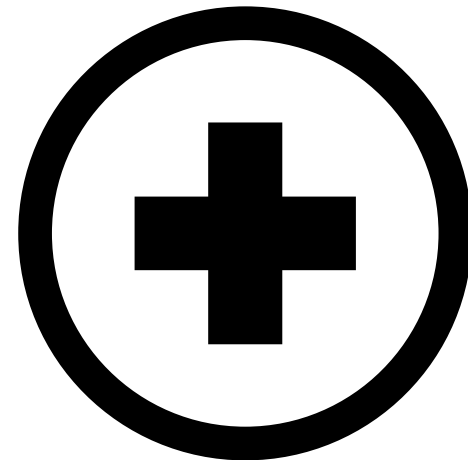
When We Are Closed

- Go to A&E

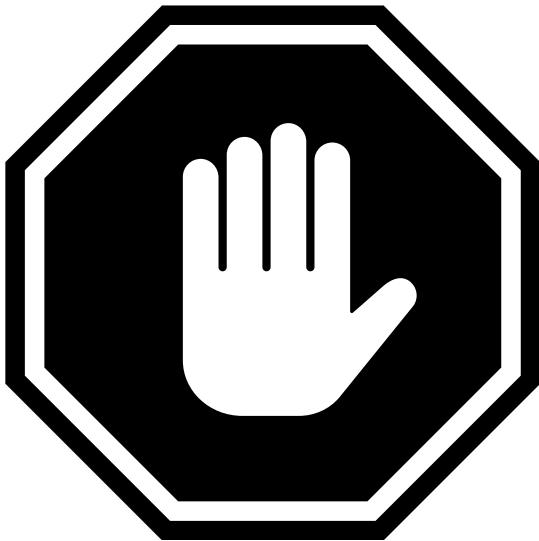


Zero Tolerance

People may be asked to leave.

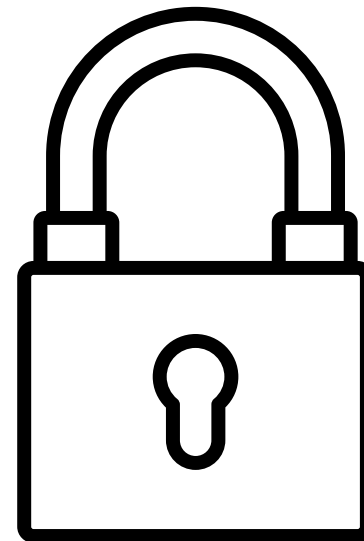


Your Information
